Overnight: Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center

December 9, 2024 - Arlington Cemetery and Monument Lights

Kennedy**, Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, Robert F. Kennedy, Audie Murphy and thousands of soldiers from every major U.S. war. Its **Tomb of the Unknowns** speaks of a nation's debt to the many whose ultimate sacrifice helped make this nation free. You'll then visit the **Pathway of**

Peace to view the always impressive **National Christmas Tree**, a large evergreen placed in the Ellipse near the White House. Each year since 1923, the massive tree has been decorated for Christmas and traditionally lit by America's President. After tonight's included dinner, you'll take an **Illuminated Monument Driving Tour**, seeing the **Kennedy Center**, **Washington Monument**, the **Marine Corps Memorial (Iwo Jima Statue)**, the **Air Force Memorial** and more. Washington's grand buildings, memorials, and monuments gleam brightly enough in daytime, but when illuminated at night, their solid stones and bronzes seem even more detailed, as fountains and water features shimmer in reflection and shadows deepen to better highlight the floodlit surfaces. Impressive in daylight - truly stunning at night!

Overnight: Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center (B/D)

December 10, 2024 - National Cathedral and Hillwood Estate

After breakfast you'll ride past Washington's **Embassy Row**, home to more embassies than any other city in the world. Once home to cereal heiress **Marjorie Merriweather Post**, Hillwood features one of the finest collections of Russian Imperial art and 18th-century French decorative arts. With nearly **90 Fabergé pieces** and the only **Royal Russian Crown** outside of Russia, this collection is truly astounding! After strolling the estate's gorgeous gardens, you'll top off this afternoon with your tour of the famed **Mansion on O Street** with over 100 uniquely themed rooms and 70 secret doors. Meticulously stylish and imaginative, each room is lavishly decorated with fine art, antiques and

elegant furnishings, including original Tiffany stained glass windows and wood carvings. Following tonight's included dinner at a longtime DC favorite, it's time to take your seat at the legendary **Ford's Theatre** for its music-infused production of "**A Christmas Carol**," capturing all the dramatic and heartwarming magic and joy of Dickens' Yuletide classic!

Overnight: Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center (B/L/D)

December 11, 2024 - Mount Vernon and Old Town Alexandria
